

## Instructions for Use – DIVE TEAM Diving Mask

### IMPORTANT NOTICE!!!

#### 1. Removing the Protective Film

Your diving mask is equipped with dual-lens glass and anti-fog films that prevent fogging during use. These films are protected by a factory-applied cover film, which must be removed before first use.

##### Instructions:

- The protective film is located on the **inside** of the lenses.
- Each lens has a small tab that allows you to easily grip the film.
- Carefully peel off the film from both lenses and ensure no residue is left behind.
- The mask is now ready for use.

#### 2. Adjusting the Silicone Strap

For a comfortable fit and proper sealing, it's important to adjust the strap correctly.

##### Instructions:

- The mask should fit snugly against the face without causing discomfort.
- Adjust the strap using the side buckles, which allow easy tightening or loosening.
- Tighten just enough to hold the mask firmly without creating pressure on the face.
- To check the fit, press the mask lightly against your face and **gently inhale through your nose** – if the mask stays in place without the strap, it is properly sealed.

#### 3. Mask Maintenance

Proper care will extend the life of your mask and ensure clear vision while diving.

##### **After each use:**

- Rinse the mask in clean fresh water to remove dirt, sand, or salt residue.
- Allow the mask to air dry away from direct sunlight.

##### **Avoid the following:**

- Do not touch the inside of the lenses to preserve the anti-fog coating.
- Do not use harsh cleaning agents or abrasive sponges.
- Do not store the mask under heavy objects to avoid deforming the silicone seal.

💡 **Tip:** If you need to clean the mask more thoroughly, use a mild soapy solution (e.g., water with dish soap) and rinse with lukewarm water.
